



## Summer Intern Job Description

### Job Summary:

If you have a heart for working with youth and kids, First Nations people or the inner city then this might be the right place for you! As an intern with New Beginnings Baptist Church/New Beginnings Arch Ministries you would be responsible for a few things this summer: building relationships with youth and kids in our community and modelling Christ to them in word and deed, signing up youth and kids for Summer camps; assisting the youth Director with different youth groups and drop in programs (i.e. Bible studies and outings); helping run a VBS day camp; and miscellaneous activities within the Church. We are a close-knit church with a big heart for our community in East Vancouver. We want to equip our interns for inner city ministry and help them walk their faith out in real life.

### The Ideal candidate should have:

- compassion for the poor and marginalized as well as a willingness to learn or be familiar with First Nations culture
- a steady relationship with Jesus and a servant's heart
- a desire to work with youth and/or kids
- the capacity to be organized and flexible with that organization

### Main Duties and Responsibilities

#### Youth Worker (20 Hours)

- Assist Youth Director in planning and implementing weekly youth events for Junior (Grades 5-7) and Senior (Grades 8-12) High as well as youth drop-in times.
- Prepare meals for and monitor youth at evening drop-ins.
- Participate in Sunday evening services at New Beginnings Baptist.

#### Camp Coordinator (16 Hours)

- Help families register their children for camp.
- Liaise with other agencies and the Ministry of Social Services to secure funding for each child/youth that would like to attend camp.
- Arrange transportation to and from ferry/boat for campers.

#### Other Responsibilities as Assigned (4 Hours)
